1. TERMS OF UTILISATION

1.1. Before entrance of the park every participant must confirm with his signature that he has read the terms of utilisation and agrees without reservation.

1.2. Before utilisation of the tree top parcours and to enter the park, under-age persons must present a signed consent explanation of the parent or the temporary guardian, who acts by order of the parent. The signatory confirms with his signature that he read the terms of utilisation, internalized them with his child and is solely responsible for the child in the park. (You find forms displayed or on www.kletterwald-bonn.de). With groups the climbing guidance is necessarily compelling by a responsible supervisor or a group management.

1.3. Children till 13 years must be guided by an adult climbing with them. Only while children go through the children's course, they can be guided from the ground. The guardian is solely responsible for the child while he is in the park and goes through the courses. Each guardian is allowed to look after maximum three children.

1.4. Everyone is allowed to take part, who is at least five years old and does not weigh over 120 kg. Five- and Six-year olds are allowed to go through the children's course by monitoring. Children from seven till nine, who can reach at least 140 cm high, are allowed to go through the children's course, the interactive course and the adventure course. Children from ten years are allowed to go through all courses by guidance.

1.5. Persons who suffer from mental or physical impairment are not allowed to enter.

1.6. Under the influence of drugs and alcohol persons are not allowed to climb.

1.7. Participants must pay the entrance fee.

1.8. The entrance fee is displayed.

1.9. The utilization begins after the safety-related introduction.

2. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

2.1. Entering the park and going through the courses take place at your own risk.

2.2. Before going through the tree top parcours every participant must take part in the safety instructions given by a BRONX ROCK staff member. A BRONX ROCK coach checks the safety-techniques in the introductory course.

2.3. The BRONX ROCK equipment must be used according to the safety instructions. It must be put on and taken off by a BRONX ROCK staff member. It must not be handed others. It is forbidden to leave the park with the equipment put on. You must not use your own equipment. Any damage of the equipment must be reported to a BRONX ROCK staff member. When exceeding the utilizations time, you must pay a 5 € fee for every started hour.

2.4. Participants must waive climbing, if he is not able to follow the safety-related rules. The participant will get back 50% of the entrance fee.

2.5. Every BRONX ROCK staff member's instruction must be followed.

2.6. The staff members reserve their right to exclude persons, who do not follow the instructions. In these cases there is no refund.

2.7. The participant must be connected with the karabiner snap link to the wire rope at all times! In the courses **TWO** karabiners must be clipped in the wire rope in the opposite direction. Follow the rule: one hand holds on tight, the other one reallocates the karabiner! While reallocating **ONE** karabiner is connected to the wire rope at all times. Please ask for help in case of uncertainty of handling!

2.8. In rope slides a pulley must be used **additionally** to the karabiners. Make sure that no one is standing on the arrival platform. Keep your legs stretched forwards at all times, if necessary slow down yourself with one hand behind the pulley.

2.9. Maximum three persons are permitted to stand on the same platform at the same time. The obstacles in between the trees must be used by one participant at a time.

2.10. Slower participants must offer others to overtake them on a platform.

2.11. While going through the courses nothing must be taken with you to avoid danger (camera, watch, jewellery, mobile phone, rucksack, etc.).

2.12. Long hair needs to be tied up or kept together with a cap.

2.13. On the tree top parcours' area visitors must stay on the paths.

2.14. On the tree top parcours' area there is absolute prohibition of smoking.

3. LIABILITY

3.1. The operator does not stick for material damages and personal damages which occur from incorrect use of the park or the equipment. Excluded are any damages caused by physical deficits or lack of concentration.

3.2. The operator is only liable for material damages in case of a staff member's act of gross negligence.

3.3. By the safekeeping of objects the operator takes over no liability for theft or damage.

3.4. The participant is liable for any damages of the park or the equipment caused by his use.

3.5. BUSINESS

3.6. To take photos or videos for commercial purposes is prohibited. The BRONX ROCK tree top parcours operator reserves the right to take photos and videos and to install a webcam for commercial and informative purposes in the entire park. In case the participant does not agree with it, he must give notice previously.

3.7. The BRONX ROCK tree top parcours reserves the right to close the business for safety-related reasons (e.g. weather). In this case there is no refund of the entrance fee.

3.8. If a participant leaves the climbing wood ahead of time by own request, he must not claim partial or complete refund of the entrance fee.

3.9. The invalidity of several regulations does not constitute generally the invalidity of all regulations.
